Message from the Vicar

I remember hearing about a school assembly years ago where the Vicar brought in a plastic lunchbox and told the secondary school age students that the box contained the most dangerous weapon in the world!!! He invited them to guess what it was.

Some said a bomb. Others said a virus. Others thought it was a gun. All of them thought that the Vicar was joking because he wouldn't be allowed to bring anything dangerous into school.

But then the Vicar opened the box... inside was... a cow's tongue from the butcher's. The Vicar explained that it wasn't the cow's tongue which was dangerous, it was the human tongue.

With it we can discourage, undermine, lie and start rumours.

We can be careless and thoughtless.

And it is contagious.

One cruel word can make more and more people suffer who weren't even there at the first word, because people pass on the hurt.

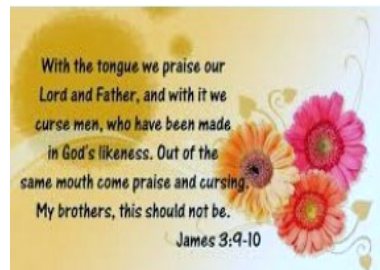
