Cast your memory back to the 'Lock Down'. Do you remember when we weren't allowed to go out to socialise?

For some people this felt like the end of the world. For others, they had a REASON to not go out and mix! Some people preferred to work from home, so when rules lifted, it was hard to integrate again.

There are some rules we can use as a reason (or excuse) to not do something we don't want to. This is a misuse of the rules.

The best rules bring freedom to do things safely. The worst rules are to exert control. Sadly, the best rules can also be misused as control and excuses to hide behind.

The Sabbath rules of keeping a day of rest, holy and set aside to God, are vitally important.

We need to stop long enough for reflection and recharging our sustaining relationship with God.

Without that we are running our engines on fumes not fuel. But if we always hide behind the rules so we don't have to do something which would benefit others, without trying to find an alternative, then we need to examine our motivation for 'keeping the rules'.

Jesus seemed to break the rules on the Sabbath by healing people. He wasn't breaking rules. He was fulfilling their true meaning.

Sabbath is to bring freedom in God. By healing on the Sabbath, Jesus brought true freedom to those bound by affliction.
